

Hartpury Parish Council
Minutes of an extra-ordinary meeting held on Tuesday 13th December 2022 at 7.30pm
at Hartpury Village Hall

Present Cllr Alastair McGhee, Cllr R Gregory, Cllr R Watson, Cllr R Pett, Cllr M Clarke.
 The meeting was chaired by Cllr A. McGhee and the minutes were taken by the Clerk.

1. Apologies for absence

Apologies were received and accepted from Cllr S Gibbs.

2. Declarations of Interest

There were no declarations of interest made.

3. Public Consultation

There were no members of the public present

4. Footpaths

- The kissing gate/permissive path from Corsend Road through the field to the Orchard Centre and from Blackwells End was discussed, Cllr Alastair McGhee is to ask permission from the Landowner and the Clerk is to check with Suzanne Hopes to ask if the Parish Council are allowed to install a gate as it is not an official path just useful.
- Ancient Footpath 23 was discussed, this footpath, which continued from Footpath 22, was previously extinguished by an official order and it was agreed the Clerk would check with Suzanne Hopes if an extinguishment order can be overturned.
- It was agreed to ask for Footpath 22 to be signposted, if the footpath is not accessible the Clerk is to ask if it can be slightly re-routed to allow access.
- The Clerk is to invite Andrew Houldey to attend an extra-ordinary meeting in February re Footpaths.
- Cllr R Gregory is to revisit the priorities checklist for actions to be taken so these can be discussed further.
- Cllr A McGhee is to discuss the footpath over the bridge with Andy Hoper as there is no way to off at one end.
- Cllr A McGhee is to inspect the missing tred on the bridge by the Orchard Centre with a view to repairing and will also speak to Suzanne Hopes to see what action can be taken on the wet area on the footpath from Hiams Lane to Woolridge Hill to make crossing easier for walkers.
- Cllr M Clarke is to check if the fallen tree has been removed from the footpath past the Old School.
- Cllr a McGhee is to look at the Footpath off the A417 (just past Danford Lane) which has been taped up.
- Cllr A McGhee is to touch base with the new Principal at Hartpury College and University to discuss the permissive path across the College/University ground, by the Church, that was agreed by Dan Evans.
- It was agreed that A4 copies of the map of the Jubilee Walk should be considered for inside/outside the Village Hall and the Bus Shelter, Cllr R Gregory is to speak to the Company he has been in touch with to obtain costs for the redesign that would be needed.
- The board of maps at the Church has fallen over, Cllr A McGhee is to speak to Jim regarding the re-instatement of the board.
